

AMERICAN ASPHALT COMPANY AWARDS & RECOGNITION

ABC The Association Builders and Contractors' STEP (Safety Training and Evaluation Process) Platinum Award was presented to American Asphalt Company for each of the years from 2001-2007. The STEP program was established in 1989 by the ABC National Environment, Health & Safety (EH&S) Committee to recognize ABC member companies with exceptional safety records. There are four levels of achievement in the STEP program which include: Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum. STEP Platinum recipients represent companies with a proven track record of safety, having achieved the STEP Gold or Platinum level the previous year. Only about 2% of all ABC members companies receive the STEP Platinum award with OSHA recordable incident rates well below the national average. The STEP award evaluates safety training programs by using 20 standard "key components" of safety. Each key component focuses on specific safety and training areas essential to a successful, effective safety training program. STEP recognizes companies that go above and beyond OSHA requirements for a safe workplace!

NAPA The National Asphalt Pavement Association's DIAMOND ACHIEVEMENT COMMENDATION was presented to American Asphalt Company each year for the years 1999-2007 for the W. Collingswood Heights plant and 2004-2007 for the Burlington Township plant. The Diamond Achievement Commendation is a unique and respected self-assessment program recognizes excellence in hot mix asphalt plant/site operations. NAPA developed the award program in 1999 to address six essential facets of the HME plant/site including: appearance, operations, environmental practices, safety, permitting and regulatory compliance, and community relations. Earning the commendation exemplifies the commitment to excellence in all aspects of HMA facilities, and symbolizes continuous improvement in operations and community relations.

UTCA The Utility and Transportation Contractors Association's WORK SAFE Award was presented to American Asphalt Company each year for the years 2002-2007. The award recognizes outstanding achievement in construction safety and health.
